The Sisters of the Good Samaritan are seeking a Care Support Worker to assist a number of Sisters living in the community. This role offers the opportunity to make a positive difference in the lives of the Sisters in your care.

When Archbishop John Bede Polding founded the Sisters of the Good Samaritan in 1857, he chose this name because he firmly believed that their work was about being neighbour to the poor and destitute women and children of Sydney. For over 160 years the Sisters of the Good Samaritan have been inspired by a simple yet powerful story, the Parable of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10:25-37.) They take as a living instruction Jesus' command to go and 'be neighbour' to those most in need.

To be successful in this role you will have:

- A commitment to caring for the elderly
- Ability to deal effectively and professionally with a range of Sisters and their Health Consultants
- Ability to assist Sisters in areas that may include personal care, socialisation and mobility
- Ability to respond appropriately to the individual requirements of the Sisters

Essential Qualifications and experience

- 3-5 years' experience in Community Health, Aged Care or Pastoral Care
- Division 2 Registered Nurse, Certificate 3 in Aged Care or equivalent
- A current Australian Drivers Licence and access to a registered vehicle
- Provide proof of current vaccination against COVID-19
